*****BUILDING BYLAW*****

The Municipal Building Bylaw requires that nonagricultural construction, demolition or removal of buildings shall require the submission of a Building Permit Application prior to commencing <u>any</u> construction. Permit application forms are available at the RM office. Permits will not be issued until all applicable fees are paid.

DEVELOPMENT BYLAW

Most developments within the municipality require a development permit. Please contact the municipal office for information before proceeding with <u>any</u> development.

MUNICIPAL MILL RATE

THE MUNICIPAL MILL RATE FOR 2017 IS SET AT 7.5.

PROPOSING A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE COLLECTION, STORAGE AND DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE WITHIN CERTAIN AREAS – ORGANIZED HAMLET OF MAYFAIR, ORGANIZED HAMLET OF MULLINGAR, SE 34–48–09 W3, E½ 35–48–12 W3, PLAN 78B14134 AND PLAN 101878476. THE BYLAW WOULD RESTRICT SEWAGE DISPOSAL TO STORAGE/HOLDING TANKS ONLY AND THAT IF ANYONE HAS CONCERNS WITH THE PROPOSED BYLAW TO CONTACT THE RM OFFICE.

Animals Roaming at Large

Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the R.M., action may be taken to restrain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animals' owner.

Approaches

Contact your councillor or RM office prior to building any approaches along right-of ways, as APPROVAL is REQUIRED by council prior to any construction and will be billed for any unauthorized work. If an individual desires to address council on an issue at a meeting, please call the RM office to be scheduled in as a delegation on the agenda.

DRAINAGE

The construction and operation of most drainage works requires the approval from Water Security Agency. Please discuss with staff at the Water Security Agency regional office at 306-445-7450 prior to any drainage.

MUNICIPAL MAPS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE COST OF \$12.00 EACH. MAPS CAN BE MAILED OUT FOR AN ADDITIONAL \$2.00.

All organic farmers are encouraged to register all their organic lands to the RM office as to let commercial pesticide applicators take the necessary precautions to avoid spray drift onto such lands.

The RM of Meeting Lake does not cover the cost of application on dust control products. Residents interested in purchasing and applying approved dust control products may do so at their expense. Please contact the RM office of location where dust control products were applied so that the grader operator will refrain from grading that portion of road.

Controlled Burning

Always report your planned control burn to avoid possible fire call costs. When burning grass, bush piles, stubble, etc. please be sure you are wellprepared and that you have fire guards in place. Call these burns into the Control Burn Centre at 1-866-404-4911.
