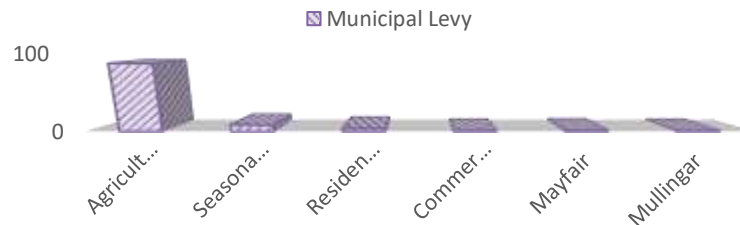

Discounts on Payments of Current Year Taxes if paid by:

August 31 st -	6%
September 30 th -	5%
October 31 st -	3%
November 30 th -	1%

Tax payments are DUE – December 31.

*Penalties on arrears of taxes remain at a rate of 1% per month compounded.

*The office accepts full or partial payments of taxes at any time.

*Postdated cheques are accepted.

*It is your responsibility to review your tax notice(s) and receipt(s) to make sure all the taxes you want paid prior to December 31 of each year are paid.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to section 293 of The Municipalities Act: agriculture residences may be exempt from taxation, fully or partially for the value of their Ag land. Please fill out the application form on our website and return to the RM office prior to March 31st, 2026.



Controlled Burn

Always report your planned control burn to avoid possible fire call costs. When burning please be sure you are well-prepared and that you have fire guards in place. Prior to any burning, call the Control Burn Centre: **1-866-404-4911**

Fire Insurance Coverage

Ratepayers are responsible for any firefighting charges when the fire department is called for a fire on your property.

Please ensure to have adequate fire insurance/liability coverage for any accidental fires.

We kindly remind everyone to remain clear of emergency zones and allow space for first responders to perform their critical duties safely and effectively.

CUSTOM WORK

Custom work agreement forms are required to be filled out and signed prior to any custom work being done.

The municipality will not be responsible for removal of snow on any seasonal roads/non-maintained roads with the exception to a ratepayers' residence where it is being heated during the winter months. The ratepayer who requests the seasonal roads/non-maintained roads to be opened, will be invoiced accordingly. Any other requests will be at discretion of council.

****DEVELOPMENT AND BUILDING PERMITS****

Development Permits and Building Permits are required when: new construction, building renovations or when changes are necessary and when buildings are moved into the municipality.

- Both application forms are available on-line or at the RM office.
- Permits will not be issued until all applicable fees are paid.

DUST CONTROL

Ratepayers may put environmentally friendly dust control down in front of their residence at their own cost. Ratepayers are required to sign a dust control policy prior to putting dust control down.

Snow Ridging Easements

This easement is essential with allowing the RM access to ridge snow on private property which helps manage the amount of snow blowing onto the roads and helps keep the snow off of critical areas so that roads remain clear and passable.

Reminders:

- ❖ Ratepayers cannot do any type of maintenance such as grading or leveling on municipal roads or property; and cannot farm/crop main grid municipal road allowance as they will be cut with mower if it is within the one pass of 15 feet, shoulder cut.
- ❖ Please dispose of grain bags properly by recycling.
- ❖ Keeping animals within your property is the responsibility of the owner. If your animals are roaming within the R.M. action may be taken to restrain the animals and all costs incurred in doing so will be the responsibility of the animal's owner.

Landfill Changes

The Waste container/bins are provided for ratepayers for:
Household Waste **ONLY**—Must be bagged

Other Materials Accepted at the Landfill:

Appliances
Metals
Non-Treated/Non-Painted Wood
Recyclables

Materials NOT Accepted:

Hazardous Materials – tires, propane tanks, batteries, paint/solvent containers, oil/filters/oil jugs or chemicals/pesticides
Contaminated Soils/Dirt/Gravel
Burning Barrels/Ashes Carcasses
Asbestos Shingles
Grain of any Type Twine
Electronics Concrete
Furniture is NO LONGER accepted

While some rural residents utilize our landfill service, others may find it economical to have bins in their own yard and may chose to share the bins and costs with neighbours.
