GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR RECYCLING.

Use your bin for the storage and collection of approved recyclables only.

Please do not bag or tie your recyclables except plastic bags and shredded paper.

Do not paint or mark your bin.

Bin lids must be completely closed for safety to the surrounding property and prevention of windblown materials.

For your childs safety do not allow them to play near the collection containers or vehicles.


