A single stream recycling program is the easiest and most effective way to show your commitment to the environment. With a single stream program, all recyclable materials can be placed into your blue bin together - no more sorting or separating required! By this simple action, you are helping to divert over 50% of your household waste from the landfill! Single stream recycling keeps our community clean, green and ensures a vibrant and sustainable future for generations to come.

## GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR RECYCLING.

Use your bin for the storage and collection of approved recyclables only.

Please do not bag or tie your recyclables except plastic bags and shredded paper.

Do not paint or mark your bin.

Bin lids must be completely closed for safety to the surrounding property and prevention of windblown materials.

For your child's safety do not allow them to play near the collection containers or vehicles.

By following these instructions you will assist in making your community one of the cleanest and greenest in Saskatchewan!

- 4 - 6 Yd<sup>3</sup> Split Bins

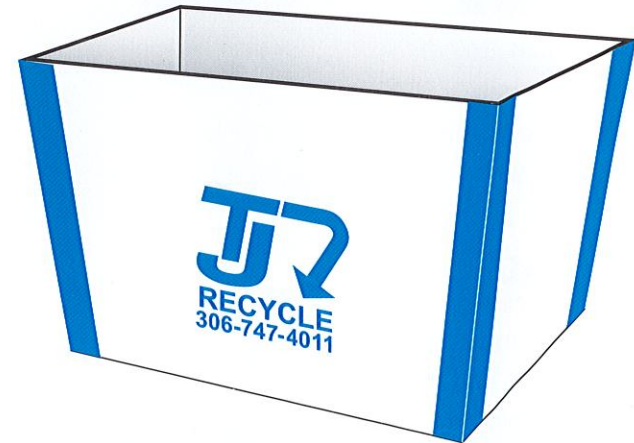
### Allowable Materials

- Household
- Construction, max. 4' length
- Furniture, broken down
- Drained oil containers, lids off

### Not Accepted

- Hazardous Waste
- Oil, Paint, Chemical Liquid
- Tires, Batteries
- Concrete
- Appliances
- Excessive amounts of soil
